## SEED DISTRIBUTION - DECEMBER 1995

### NOTES:

1. Please read the following instructions carefully before ordering.
2. All requests for seed should be made immediately on the receipt of the Journal to Mrs D. Minors, 79 Osbourne Road, Brincliffe, Sheffield S11 9BA.
3. Indicate your selection by **underlining** those required on the Distribution List. If more than one packet is required of a particular species, write the number of packets before the name.
4. If at all possible, you will receive seeds of your choice, but many species are available only in small quantities and substitutes may have to be sent. Please indicate alternatives (**reasonable numbers**) by putting a tick against their names.
5. The Distribution List is your order form and will be returned with your seeds. Fill in your name and address in the space provided below. If in addition you provide a self-adhesive addressed label, this will enable the Seed Distributor to process your order more rapidly.
6. Because of the heavy initial demand and disruption of postal services over the Christmas period, no orders will be dispatched before the New Year. In any case allow 28 days for delivery before enquiring--interruptions to deal with enquiries while the seed distributor is packing orders only delays the work further!
7. Make cheques and postal orders payable to BCSS. Add 60p to the total amount for your order to cover postage and packing.
8. Overseas members should note the following: (a) Seeds will be sent by surface mail unless sufficient extra postage is enclosed to cover airmail rates. (b) Before placing an order, please satisfy yourself that the local Customs/ Import regulations permit entry of cactus and succulent seeds. The Society cannot be responsible for seeds which are confiscated. (c) Phytosanitary certificates cannot be supplied.
9. The seed offered is obtained from a number of suppliers and listed here under the names given by them. The Society cannot accept responsibility for incorrect names on the seed packets.
