HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR SEEDS

- (i) This order form is valid until 1st. September, 1980 only.
- (ii) Members may order up to 10 packets of seed free of charge, but stamps or a postal order must be enclosed to cover postage (inland 10 or 12p, abroad 2 international postal coupons).
- (iii) Additional packets (one only of any kind) may be ordered at 5p (U.S.A. and Canada: 10 cents) each, making postal orders etc. payable to "The Cactus and Succulent Society of Great Britain".
- (iv) If remitting in a currency other than sterling, members must add the equivalent of 70p (U.S.A. and Canada \$1.50) to cover the exchange transaction.
- (v) Where postage or the exchange fee is underpaid, part of the money sent for seeds will be used to meet these expenses and fewer packets of seed will be supplied.
- (vi) Please underline on the list, the species that you require and tick (✓) any you would like as substitutes in the event of your first choice being out of stock.
- (vii) Fill in your name and membership number and the amount enclosed for any additional seeds on the form below.
- (viii) Print your address on the gummed label provided and send it, together with a stamp, this seed list and any remittance to:
